Each stands on a clay base, with several bearing artisan signatures including S. Peirano, J.-P. Maïkacchi, Claude Carbozel, and Paul, respected names associated with mid-century Provençal santon making. Sculpted facial expressions, finely modeled hands, and carefully sewn garments give each figure a distinct personality and reflect the skilled craftsmanship behind these collectible works of French folk art. This decorative ensemble is in excellent condition commensurate with age and use, retaining rich colors, intact textiles, and the authentic handcrafted character that defines true Provençal santons.
